1. The meeting was called to order at 7:32 pm by Patrick Jung.

February 19th is the Drauden concert which is held at Plainfield South at 6pm in the auditorium. Next Thursday is the choir concert, called Choral winds, in which the wind ensemble is featured. Next Friday is the last pep game of the season with a call time of 4:45. February 25th at 6pm in the auditorium we will be having a Disney Trip meeting for all Freshman, Sophomores and Juniors parents. February 27th is our Skyzone fundraiser. March 3rd is our band concert at 6:30. March 7th is PICBF at Plainfield Central, with Wind symphony and Wind ensemble performing. Mid-March we will be looking for volunteers for our new band trailer. Tickets go on sale tomorrow for our school musical, Little Mermaid which is March 20th-22nd.
