

PSHS Band Expenses Overview

PAYABLE WITH CREDIT CARD, CASH, OR
VIA CHECK PAYABLE TO PSHS BAND BOOSTERS

For your budgeting purposes, the following list provides details of fees and items you may be required to pay as part of your participation in the PSHS band program. You will be given a Google Form at the mandatory meeting on July 20th with more details about each line.

I. BAND EXPENDITURES: Additional costs apply depending on your grade and level of involvement.

DESCRIPTION	AMOUNT	WHO SHOULD ORDER IT
Marching Band Materials	\$30	Required for ALL students and automatically billed.
Marching Band Shoes	\$41	Required for ALL <u>new</u> members or if you need replacements
Marching Band Gloves	\$7	Required for ALL WIND PLAYERS (woodwind & brass) and automatically billed.
Color Guard Uniform	\$110	Required for ALL color guard members and automatically billed (this does NOT include shoes, gloves, makeup, or other accessories).
Color Guard Shoes (Tan)	\$38	Required for ALL <u>new</u> members or if you need replacements
Color Guard Gloves	\$17	Required for rifle line members only (you can reuse previous gloves)
Band Method Book	\$9/\$12	Required for ALL 9 th grade students (percussion book is \$12, all others are \$9)

II. BAND BOOSTER MEMBERSHIP: \$20 PER FAMILY (OPTIONAL)

Many families choose to join the Band Booster Organization. Starting with the class of 2026 (Freshman from the 2022-2023 school year), you must be a Band Booster member for all four years of high school to be eligible to apply for a senior band scholarship at the end of your senior year. ***NOTE - The class of 2024 can still apply provided they were members for 2022-2023 (Jr.) AND 2023-2024 (Sr.) and the class of 2025 can still apply provided they were members for the 2022-2023 (Soph), 2023-2024 (Jr.), and 2024-2025 (Sr.) school years.***

III. FUNDRAISER BUY-OUT: \$130 (OPTIONAL)

Students are asked to participate in fundraisers throughout the year to enhance their musical and educational experience at PSHS. Some families who choose not to participate in the fundraisers prefer to provide a "buy-out" to make up for not participating. You may cover the buy-out in one lump-sum payment or smaller amounts during each fundraiser if you prefer. The buy-out amount is the per-student amount budgeted by the Band Boosters to meet operating expenses.

** Families that pay the Buy-Out amount will not be asked to participate in our fundraisers throughout the year but ARE eligible for individual fundraiser incentives.*
